Introduction

When you look at your horoscope, that is your birth chart wheel, you will notice it is divided into 12 sections. They are called "Houses." Each house stands for an aspect of the person's life. In this birth chart, we will go house by house and discuss the major indicators therein. We can't discuss "everything" about your chart, because that would represent your entire life and would take an encyclopedia to record it. So, we'll stick with the major things, and if you want future readings about specific things, we will pull out your chart and examine it considering that question.

The symbols you see inside the houses are symbols of the planets that are watched and followed in Western Astrology. We will look at those as we come to that house. Finally, on the outside of the circle you will see the astrological sign symbols (Aries, Taurus, Gemini, etc.) These represent constellations in the sky that are tracked by astrologers. So, when one talks about their "sun sign," they are talking about the astrological constellation their sun was in on the day they were born. I'm sure you've heard it said that you're a Capricorn, and that is true, but you are a very special kind of Capricorn, and we'll get to that in the analysis.

First, we will look at your Sun sign, your moon sign, then your rising sign and each of the 12 houses.

Now, you sent a message and asked the following: "I would like a birth chart analysis please. I was born at 2:43 p.m. December 21st 1988. I come from a long line of Psychics with many different gifts such as telekinesis, pyrokinesis, Clairvoyance scene, mediumship. I need to know if these gifts have been passed to me. I also feel that I am destined for greatness but I need to know if it's for real and not just my ego. Sometimes I feel like it's all in my head." We will certainly consider this for you in this analysis.

The Astrological Style

There are all kinds of astrological systems used throughout the world. If you were to have your chart done in some other system, it would give you different results than I am giving you. What makes one system more valid than another, in my opinion, is how well the charts that are created from it either describe the real world or predict the future. I am an experienced and well-educated professional astrologer. I have studied astrological systems academically for a number of years and I have done original research that contributes to the field. So, in my opinion, the system of astrology I use is the best.

Specifically I use what is called Western Astrology. This astrology dates back to the Hellenistic era of Ancient Greece, but it has evolved over the centuries since. Today, it is the most popular system in use, and most people in the Western World are unfamiliar with any other style. It is the most popular style, quite simply, because it has proven to work so well. If you or any other astrologer wants to know the specifics, they need only look at your chart page where I note the house division system and the stipulations I use. I highly recommend that you always stick with these parameters when studying your horoscope.

The Analysis

Your Sun Sign

Your natal sun (the position of your sun at the time of your birth) is 0 degrees Capricorn. That means you were born on the "cusp" of Capricorn, and the cusp is the most powerful position of a sign. Moreover, your sun is in the 8th house. The sun is the primary fatalistic force acting on our lives--that's what it symbolizes. It is not necessarily what people know about you, or even what you may know about yourself. Sometimes a whole life must be lived to really see it's fruit-



tion. But you are like a super-Capricorn, because you were born on the cusp of Capricorn. You were born on the Winter Solstice.

Capricorn is an earth sign, so you are practical, hardworking, and very driven, very ambitious. Isn't it amazing that you said to me prior to this analysis that you felt destined for greatness? That's the Capricorn ambition you feel. It's driving you hard. Remember, you're on the cusp. Of course, you can also be uncompromising. You may find

it hard to be tolerant of others that aren't measuring up, and you may find that you are thus somewhat pessimistic and fatalistic. The fatalism shows when you say that you feel "destined."



So, are you destined for something great? Yes. What it is, I'm not exactly sure, but maybe as we finish this analysis, we'll see it more clearly. One thing's for sure, you will never be satisfied until you are on the path to the greatness you are destined for. Some people never find that "thing." But you won't stop until you do. That's the Capricorn nature--and maybe even a bit of its curse. Happiness for a Capricorn can sometimes be an elusive thing.

Your Moon Sign

Your moon is the fatalistic force that drives you "emotionally." Your moon is in your first house, and it is in the sign of Gemini. Gemini is the sign of communication, intelligence, thought, and downright IQ.

You derive emotional satisfaction by expressing how you feel to others, but even more than that, you have a great deal of emotional intelligence. You can understand people and how they tick. You can see into human motivations and you can give a voice to them.

With your moon in Gemini, you can also expect to quite often feel conflicted about things. You could be prone to depression. Gemini is two-faced. It feels one way at one moment and the opposite the next moment. This is something you should watch out for. It can affect your relationships making you hot for someone one minute, and cold to them the next. This is not a good recipe for social success, so be on your guard and know that such a fatalistic force is acting upon you.

So, if we combine the forces of your Sun and Moon. We find a very ambitious go-getter who can think on her feet, is highly intelligent, and understands the motivations of people. Something big is surely on your horizon.

Ascendant (the Rising Sign)


The Ascendant is the fatalistic force that forms your outward personality. It's what you show to people, and it colors the sun and moon forces in your life. Your rising sign is Taurus. This means that people will see you as a sensual person, someone who likes pleasure and the good things in life, maybe even a material girl. You would also be stubborn, intractable and steadfast. When you say "This is how it is," You don't budge from that. You are also seen as dependable and hardworking. And this isn't just a pretense with you. It also forms the parts about you that you like about yourself. So, speaking of "yourself," let's start with the first house...

1st House

The first house is the house of the "self." The cusp of the first house is the rising sign. Now, your first house is influenced by Taurus and Gemini. So, you are a very skilled and dedicated person. More than that, in your first house resides your moon and Jupiter. So, you are an emotional person, for all the good and all the bad that implies. You can love deeply, and you can hate just as hard. But there's some good news here. Jupiter is in your first house. Jupiter is the planet of good fortune--you, yourself, are going to have great fortune in life. You are going to get what you want. You're a lucky person. And because Jupiter is in Taurus in your 1st house, it translates as you, yourself, will have material luck.

2nd House

This is the house of wealth, materialism, and money. It is dominated by Cancer. Cancer is the sign of motherly caring and nurturing. This tells me that you want things not only for yourself, but so that you can take care of others as well. You would understand the saying quite well that you can't give unless you have it to give. You are that kind of person. You will be rich, but you could probably never be selfish.



3rd House

Your third house is pretty evenly influenced by Cancer and Leo. the 3rd house is the house of communication ability and intelligence. Cancer is the sign of caring and Leo is the sign of entitlement, gregariousness, and leadership. This tells me that academically, you are are a great politician. You'd certainly understand the nuances of leadership.

4th House

The 4th House is the house of family and motherhood. I just don't have a lot to say on this now. It's benign and it combines traits of Virgo and Leo. I think it's somewhat pedestrian to your life. Neither exceptionally good nor bad. You'd be a good mother. You probably have a good relationship with your mother. We could certainly look deeper into it at another time, but it will always serve more as a backdrop for the planets that transit through it throughout your life.

5th house

Your 5th House is the house of romance, sex, fertility, and creativity. Yours is somewhat uneventful. It is dominated equally by Virgo and Libra. Virgo is all about analysis, intelligence, health and conservatism. Libra is all about being fair, just and possessing equality. Your 5th house to me is not exceptionally passionate. I don't think sex is your primary driving force; I also don't think it would be easy for you to get pregnant. I don't think you'll have a lot of kids in this life. I don't know if you are, but you might find an alternative lifestyle suits you better than a traditional man/woman situation. I'm not saying you're gay or straight. I'm only suggesting that you don't rule anything out.

6th House

This is where things start to get interesting. Pluto is in your house of work and service, the 6th House. Why is that? Why is the planet of the occult and all things dark and taboo in your house of work and service? You're certainly intelligent enough to do any job you want. Being a super-Capricorn with a Taurus/Jupiter rising sign tells me you would do well in any interview for work or at any job you set your mind to, but I don't think your mind could be happy with an "ordinary" job. You have some dark forces driving your job prospects. This is not surprising. I think you can see how we are moving toward the 8th house. Pluto is the ruler of the 8th house, so your 6th house and 8th house are connected. Not only that, but the sign of Scorpio is completely interned in your 6th House. Pluto rules the sign of Scorpio. It is the sign of all things psychic, dark, and occult. So, Pluto is there supercharging Scorpio in your house of work. I think we're beginning to see where your seeds of greatness are planted.

7th House

This is the house of relationships, marriage, and friendships. Interestingly, you have Venus in your 7th house. Venus is the planet of the 5th house. It brings the forces of love, sex, and creativity to bear. This shows me that you can be romantic, but you will only be your passionate, sexual self in the confines of a committed relationship. And since Sagittarius (the sign of travel) dominates your 7th house. I think you might find yourself in your most committed relationship with someone foreign born.

8th House

Obviously, this is a big house for you. This house has five planets all close together. It's dominated by Capricorn. My God, the psychic forces you must feel pulling you are incredible. The 8th house is all about dark, occult, psychic things. And do you know what is so amazing, Jane? If I were to select a model to represent the eighth house, it would be you in your black clothes holding your python. You are a symbol of the 8th house. See how astrology plays out? See how it works? I am not going to describe each planet in your 8th house. It would simply be too much work, and too much to read, and we've already talked about your sun sign. The fact is; however, you have a serious destiny in the psychic arts.

You asked if the psychic talents from your ancestors has passed to you. The answer is, no. God, Himself, has incarnated you as a psychic powerhouse. Nothing is handed down to you--You are the person that passes down gifts in "your" lineage. You're an original. You're the first in a line. In fact, we must skip to the 12th house now to close this circle.

12th House (Analyzing this out of order)

Let's just skip to the chase: Mars, the planet of power and action is in your 12th House. The 12th House is the other psychic house. Think of it as the house of feeling things. It is the house of intuition and of spiritual depth. You're an old soul, and you've brought that spiritual power with you into this life in this world. Now, combine that with the 8th House powers, and I think you're starting to see where the "greatness" you feel is coming from.

9th House

This one is a lot like your 4th House. It will be more affected by planets that transit through it throughout your life. What I do want to point out is that the end of your 9th house makes the start of your 10th House, and that is called your MC or Medium Coeli, or Midheaven and it points to your vocation in this life. Well, it is in Aquarius. Aquarius is all about originality. Your vocation, whatever it ultimately is, will be a creative, original endeavor. You will do what hasn't been done before. This is also why I talked about you being an original in the psychic depart-

ment and not a product of previous generations. I'll tell you, where they mattered to you is that they lived to bring you into existence.

10 & 11th Houses

I want to talk about these together, because the Sign of Pisces straddles them both, and Pisces is the sign of the 12th House. It means the same thing--deep spirituality. Well, the 10th House is all about your mark on the world, and the 11th house is all about your associations with organizations. Otherwise, these houses are somewhat prosaic, like the 4th House. They don't tell us much about you, but they do tell us that you probably have a vocation in some organization, perhaps one that you will create on your own or with others, that has something to do with spirituality.

Conclusion

When you know your horoscope, it gives you choices you didn't have before. Before, the fatalistic forces of the universe just pushed you along through your incarnation in this world. Now that you know about these forces, your free will can let you take them wherever you want to go. It's just like a sailor in a sailboat. The wind will push the boat wherever it will, but if the sailor takes hold of the rudder and the mainsheet, he can use the wind to sail the boat in any direction he wants to go. You are that sailor. You now know the direction of the winds blowing on your life, so you can choose to go with them or go against them. Now the choice is yours. You are the master of your fate.
